WHAT IS COMMUNITY GEOTHERMAL?

A community geothermal network uses shared underground infrastructure to deliver efficient, reliable, and affordable heating and cooling to homes, businesses, and institutions.



Instead of individual ground loops at every property, participating homes and buildings connect to a shared underground loop beneath city streets — similar to other community utilities. Each property still has its own geothermal heat pump, providing efficient, affordable year-round comfort while helping lower overall installation costs.
